INFORMATION EXTRACTED FROM SASA REGULATIONS

An applicant for an AOE Assessment must be a certificated Timekeeper.

AOE Grades

- Grade 1 An individual who is capable of establishing and operating AOE equipment in its full range of attributes and who is further able to carry out repairs to the equipment to maintain its operating integrity.
- Grade 2 An individual capable of establishing a fully operational AOE system from the integration of its various component parts and is further capable of operating such equipment to obtain the time and/or place of the competing swimmers.
- Grade 3 An individual who is capable of operating AOE equipment, which is already in place to obtain the time and/or place of the competing swimmers.

This form together with the examination fee remittance of £7.50 (payable to S.A.S.A.) to be sent to your appropriate District STO Convenor.
