

Rule 18

a: All Poolside Officials at District Events shall conform to Scottish Swimming STO regulation 10

b: East District Clubs entering swimmers for any District event must provide a number of registered officials for each session of the event in accordance with the following criteria:

Total number of accepted Club swimmers for each session	Number of Officials to provide per session
1 to 4	None
5 to 9	1(SASA volunteer level of membership or above)
10 to 19	2 (One of which must be a British Swimming Licensed Official)
20+	3 (Two of which must be British Swimming Licensed Officials)

c: An East District Club failing to provide Technical Officials (or substitutes) in accordance with the above criteria will be subject to a fine as agreed at the AGM for each official in each session in which the required number of Officials are not present; all fines to be paid within 28 days of the invoice

d: It shall be the responsibility of the Meet Management in conjunction with the District STO Convenor to identify the Clubs who do not meet their obligation;

e: It shall be the responsibility of the District STO convenor to inform the District Treasurer;

f: It shall be the responsibility of the District Treasurer to levy those fines as agreed at the AGM.

For information Scottish Swimming STO Regulation 10:

STO10.0 Uniform

STO10.1 Poolside uniform for all competitive swimming events:

Men White open-necked short sleeved shirt

White trousers, NOT SHORTS, white accessories

White poolside shoes and white socks, if worn

Women White dress or white blouse and skirt or trousers

White poolside shoes

STO10.2 Uniform requested by Gala Organisers is appropriate where a modified form of uniform is supplied directly by the Gala Convenor or Organising Committee or by an Event Sponsor. Such dress will be adopted as directed by the Meet Organisers and will replace (both in style and colour) the recommended uniform in full or part, provided such dress complies with advertising conventions specified by FINA.
