Events: The programme for each age category will be as follows:

11/12 years	100m on each of the 4 strokes
13/14 years	100m and 200m on each of the 4 strokes
15/16 years	100m and 200m on each of the 4 strokes
17 & over	100m and 200m on each of the 4 strokes
Open	200m IM and “50m Challenge”

Prizes: Prize money will be awarded as follows:

Presentations: Awards as above will be made to the swimmers placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each of the events in the age group and open categories. The only exception is the “50m Challenge” where awards as above will be made to the swimmers placed 1st & 2nd. Swimmers must report to the Presentation Marshall immediately on completing their race and collecting their dry clothes from the holding area.

Appropriate club clothing should be worn for presentations. Prize-winners, or an appointed depute, must be available for presentation as per the Presentation Schedule, a copy of which will be included in your club envelope and posted around the pool.

Entry Fee: £6.50 per event

Coach Pass: £10.00 each to cover the duration of the meet and to include pool access. All staff, coaches and team managers must have passes. Each club will receive a programme, and one set of start and results sheets.

Coffee and tea will be available all day in the Meet Office area for holders of coaches’ passes. Note that meals are not included in the Pass.

Please complete the enclosed Coaches’ Pass Form and return with your entry.

Session Times: The session times will be as follows:

SESSIONS 1 & 4	9:00 a.m.	(Warm Up: 8:00 a.m.)
SESSIONS 2 & 5	1:30 p.m.	(Warm Up: 12:30 p.m.)
SESSIONS 3 & 6	5:00 p.m.	(Warm Up: 4:30 p.m.)

Closing Date: Wednesday, 24th January 2010 at 12 noon.

Entry Times: There are no consideration times, but the organisers reserve the right to make cuts to ensure a balanced programme and the smooth running of the meet. Entry times will be long course times, however short course times converted to long course are acceptable.

Starts / Finishes: During the heats, 'over the top' starts will be used for all events except backstroke. On completion of their swim, all swimmers must leave the pool by the steps at Lane 1 only.

Competitor Cards: Time cards will not be used. Start lists will be supplied.

“50m Challenge”: The “50m Challenge” is a knockout format on each of the two days. The female event is on the Saturday and the male event is on the Sunday. The stroke is freestyle. From the heats in the first session, ten swimmers progress to the first knockout stage in the second session. From this, four swimmers progress to the second knockout stage at the beginning of the Finals session, from which two swimmers compete in a “head-to-head” at the last event. The prize money reflects the expected standard of the event.

Entries: Entries together with the appropriate Entry Fees should be forwarded to Mr John Bruce, 50 Station Road, Roslin EH25 9LR by the closing date specified. Cheques should be made payable to '**SASA East District**'. The method of entry is via a Hy-Tek generated Entry File. An Event File specifically formatted for this meet will be supplied to clubs on request, along with a full set of instructions if required. To request the File, either complete the 'Request Form' attached or preferably direct by email to Jbruce2160@aol.com. Single entries only can be submitted by email to John Bruce.

General Information:

- ◆ The competition is accredited and has obtained a licence from the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association.
- ◆ All results for the 200m events will be decided on a Heat Declared Winner basis. For all other events there will be heats plus an evening Final.
- ◆ The Main Pool will be available for warm-up purposes prior to the start of each session. This time may be 'split' to allow suitable water time and space for all age groupings.
- ◆ During the competition, the teaching pool will be available for ongoing warm up / swim down provision although the organisers reserve the right to withdraw the pool if it is being abused.
- ◆ For the safety of spectators, swimmers must not use the top corridor outside the spectator area when wearing wet swimsuits.
- ◆ A Programme of Events is attached.

- ◆ The organisers reserve the right to restrict the number of entries they accept.

Event Regulations

Entry and Entries to all events is expressly subject to each and all of these regulations and may, where appropriate, also require compliance with the facility provider's regulations:

- Permission for any person to enter or to remain within the venue notwithstanding possession of any ticket by that person is at the absolute discretion of the stewards and officers of the East District and/or any police officer.
- No guarantee can be given by the East District that the event will take place at a particular time or any particular date and East District reserves the right to reschedule the event without notice and without any liability for so doing.
- In the event of postponement, cancellation or abandonment of the event, refunds if any, will be made at the absolute discretion of the East District. The East District will have no legal liability to make a refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel and accommodation costs.
- The following are articles, which must not be brought within the venue (glasses, fireworks, smoke canisters, air horns, flares, glass bottles, weapons of any sort). Any person in possession of such items will be refused entry at the absolute discretion of any steward or officer of the East District and/or police officer.
- No object may be thrown by spectators within the venue.
- No foul or abusive language or other offensive words such as racial or sexual abuse may be used within venues.
- No alcohol may be consumed within events except in those areas specifically designated for such purposes and in accordance with any terms displayed in those areas.
- No person may for commercial purposes take photographs or use any video recording equipment inside events without the express written permission of the East District. The taking of photographs or use of video equipment for non-commercial purposes is permitted subject to compliance with SASA Ltd Guidelines with regard to video recording and zoom photography.
- **In order to control digital photographs, mobile phones may not be used in the changing village.**
- No articles, periodicals, publications, flyers or goods of any nature may be offered either free or for sale by any persons save only the East District or SASA Ltd within events without the express written permission of the East District.
- Any person entering events must at all times comply with any and all instructions of any steward or officer of the East District and/or police officer. Failure to comply within a reasonable time with any such instruction will lead to the person being invited to leave.
- The East District reserves absolutely the right to eject from events any person failing to comply with each and all of the Event Regulations.
