SASA East District – Treasurer’s Report March 2019

Income for the period was £19,172.00 and expenditure £35,168.58, a deficit of £15,996.58. This was to be expected as my previous report highlighted, we had received entry income for the early rounds of the EDAGs, however, had not received invoices for some of the associated expenses.

This was a extremely active period for the District with the accounting transactions reflecting this. Income for the period came predominantly from the Entry Fees and Door/Programme receipts for stages 3 and 4 of this year’s EDAGs competitions.

Expenditure in the period was also heavily influenced by the EDAGs with pool hire, catering, entry refunds and meet expenses amounting to £30,508.55. The other key expenditures were the master’s competition expenses (£1,348), archiving premises rental (£1,320) and the balance representing normal district expenses.

The BoS current account balance as at 28th February 2019 was £132,815.61 which once adjusted for uncleared cheques and deposits gives us a balance of £106,176.03 of which £50,000 remains ring-fenced.

Swimming Report March 2019

The Edinburgh International for 2019 is now complete. Entries were significantly lower than in previous years in particular from the youth swimmers. It seems likely this was, at least in part, due to the meet not being in the British Swimming window. This had a significant impact on our plans to upgrade meet presentation as we had to reduce expenditure wherever we could. Had it not been for the sponsorship and support received from the district, the council, the University and others, the meet could not have gone ahead. On the plus side, the quality of the open swimming was exceptional and made for some very exciting racing. We should not underestimate the achievement in being able to run a meet at this level. As ever, there are areas we can improve and a review meeting is scheduled for 3 April.

Planning is now underway for the East District Open and Long Course time trial, both being run over the weekend of 27 and 28 April. We have 5 youth event management trainees taking part in the pilot programme; 4 of them attended and assisted at EISM and I hope that they will all be present at the open and LCTT where I would like them to take a lead in some areas as well as play a more active role in the run up to the meet. Going forward, we need to link them into other more local events so that they can get hands on experience and continue their development.

Swim Committee has also agreed an approach to the Telfer Cup going forward for 2019/20, set out in the attached. Management Team is asked to consider the suggestion and if agreed, make the necessary rule changes.

Finally, an opportunity has arisen to run a coach development session for ED coaches on 24 April with Wayne Goldsmith at the RCP. Wayne is usually based in Australia and will be running a number of events in Scotland in the week commencing 20 April. We are discussing a programme involving swimmer mental skills, a pool session with coaches, followed by a workshop.

At the latest National Swim Committee there was a discussion on Rule R4.4.1: (All competitive aquatic meets held in Scotland, involving members from two or more clubs, require to be licensed by the Company). The committee concluded that composite teams can hold time trial / club champs style events without needing to apply for a licence, provided certain conditions are met (see note 1). There was further discussion about what counts as a competitive meet which we will need to discuss further at the district swim committee (see note 2).

Note 1: Rule 4.4.1

If clubs that are all in the same composite team, hold a meet, time trial or team championships together, then if everyone takes part under the composite team name then this could be classified as an internal meet and would not need a licence. If there is an element of competing for their clubs (eg club relays) then this would mean that two or more clubs were competing and a licence would be needed. Although not mentioned at the time of discussion, R5.4.4 may also come into play here because competitors representing a composite team cannot also represent their registered club in the same competition.

Note 2:

A non-threatening competitive experience which is really only about training swimmers to compete by improving their knowledge of the procedures of racing is not necessarily a competitive experience in itself and, if swimmers from more than one club are present for this purpose a licence may not be required. This would also apply where two clubs have a joint training session and finish off with a few races, including relays, for a bit of swimmer enjoyment rather than a competition.

Telfer Cup (TC) - Proposal for Management Meeting 20 March 2019

Proposal - to compute the winner of the Telfer Cup as being the club scoring the highest number of points from the mixed relay events currently run within the EDAGs programme. We run these for 4 age groups at present, with 2 events for each age group; 4x 50 medley and 4x 50 free.

Notes:

Only A teams would score points.

Points awarded from 8 to 0. A disqualified 'A' team receives zero points.

We would change the age range of older group to 17+ years in line with other relays in EDAGs.

Background

16 clubs entered the mixed relays in 2018 (6 entering 6 or more of the 8 events available) ; but only 2 clubs entered the Telfer Cup.

New rule for handbook

Telfer Cup

- 1) The Cup shall be known as the "Telfer Cup"
- 2) The Cup will be awarded to the winner of an annual competition.
- 3) Date of the competition to be set by the Swim Committee.
- 4) The competition format and rules will be managed by the Swim Committee.
- 5) Open to all District Clubs, the format is as follows;
 - The Telfer Cup will be awarded to the club gaining the highest number of points from mixed relay events in the EDAGs championships. The events in which points can be gained are the 200m mixed freestyle and 200m mixed medley relays for each of the age groups specified in the EDAGs meet information.
 - Only 'A' teams may score points. Points will be awarded in each event from 8 points for first place, 7 points for second place, down to zero points. A disqualified team earns zero points.

Format in 2018 – 19 this year was :

There are four team events. Each team in each event will comprise 2 females and 2 males.

Saturday

4 x 50m Freestyle Relay, two aged 11/12 and two aged 13/14

4 x 100m Medley Relay, all from Open ages (11-18 - see below)

Sunday

4 x 50m Medley Relay, two aged 11/12 and two aged 13/14

4 x 100m Freestyle Relay, all from Open ages (11-18 - see below)

No swimmer can compete more than once, so a full team will comprise 16 swimmers. Swimmers in the open relays can be any age within the EDAG age groups (11-18); age as at 31 December 2019.

March Synchro Report

Grades

18 swimmers from Edinburgh and 5 from Fife took part in the first figure grade assessment day of the year in February. 15 Edinburgh swimmers passed, one with Silver, and all Fife swimmers passed, two of them passing two grades in the same session.

Competitions

Swim England National Age Groups – Manchester

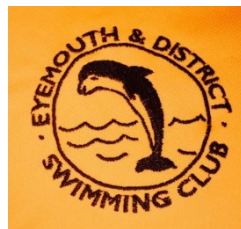
Following the change in the synchro calendar the Swim England NAGs 2019 were held just over three months after the 2018 competition. In 2018 Edinburgh swimmers were part of a Synchro Caledonia team that competed. This year Synchro Caledonia is focused on skills days so Edinburgh took a team to the competition in Manchester instead.

The eight swimmers who qualified took part in the figure and free team sections. The Mr Robot team performed brilliantly, coming 8th in routine-only scores and maintaining their 11th place overall.

Scottish Figure Competition – RCP

The Scottish Figure Competition is being held on Saturday 24 March. Edinburgh has 20 swimmers entered and the Junior swimmers will be competing in technical events for the first time.

Summary

Overall clubs are maintaining a healthy and active membership with some concerns over Hawick and Teviotdale who did not field any swimmers at EDAG's and are not currently represented on the Borders Regional Swim Committee. We will continue to monitor the achievements at EDAGs and SNAGs which has dropped slightly since last year.

East District Water Polo Summary for March

Scottish Competitions continue with 6 leagues running and 6 Scottish Cup competitions. ED clubs sit high in the current league tables whilst clubs continue to adjust to single gender leagues.

Scottish competitions are changing to an academic year cycle so will all finish in time for the summer holidays. It is anticipated that ED clubs will again feature prominently in the Scottish Cup finals in June.

Caledonia men narrowly missed promotion to Division 1 in the BWPL and will play in Division 2 next season along with Portobello men. Caledonia women have had a tough Super 5's and complete their season this weekend in Lancaster. They will start next season in Division 1. Caledonia Storm will start in Division 5 next season. **The BBC will be broadcasting live games from the Super 5's finale weekend on 23/24 Mar and may feature Caledonia women on Saturday.** Social media is being used to promote the event.

The first round of the Swim England National Age Groups have taken place with Caledonia U19 boys progressing to the qualifier round this weekend 23/24 Mar whilst the U17 boys failed to progress and have dropped into the plate competition. ED clubs have provided the core of both boys' teams and some ED girls have also been part of the KKASC U17 girls' team who have progressed to the qualifiers also taking place this weekend.

Two ED water polo forums have taken place and useful discussions have taken place. The East water polo academy, which was being held on Fri nights at RCP, has been suspended primarily due to lack of coaches and staff.

Dominique Zahra (Warr), Thomas Cameron (DWPC), Aithne Lawrence (DWPC), Eve Meadows (Warr) have all been recommended to attend GB 2001 born trials. Hopefully they'll join Niamh Moloney and Harry Gray, both DWPC, in the GB junior programme.

The Scottish WP Dev Officer Neal Rayner (Warr) has stepped down and the post is currently vacant pending discussions between SWP Chair and Scottish Swimming on future options. Neal will continue as SCO Ladies coach.

The Scotland senior womens squad for the EU nations in Brno Czech Republic 24th - 26th May 2019 has been announced and the team is well represented by players from East clubs.

STO Convenor report to Management meeting 21 March 2019

We have had a busy start to 2019 with the ED Age Groups Finals and EISM both at the RCP.

There was an excellent turn out of officials at the Finals with the deck fully staffed for all sessions and several ad-hoc judge training sessions took place over the weekend. These were also well attended and allowed several officials to undertake assessments since.

We were well supported by officials from across British Swimming at the EISM and this allowed for the deck to be fully staffed for all sessions. The FINA appointed officials Jane Whittle (Referee) and Sam Chadwick (Starter) provided very positive feedback and were satisfied that the meet was conducted in compliance with the FINA requirements.

This event also saw the Meet Referee, Andrew McRoberts IH, standing down from this level of event. Andrew had been the EISM Meet Referee since it's reintroduction to the calendar. He now feels the time is right to step back from the poolside and will be taking an extended sabbatical from swimming but we do hope we will see him back in some capacity in the future.

Officials Training and Development
